

Do you think a visit to the veterinarian is all about the shots?

Vaccinations provide important protection for your kitten. But, in addition to the vaccines that control viruses and bacterial diseases, your regular visits assure early detection of other illnesses that can be even more important in extending your pet's life. Only a doctor's physical exam and diagnostic testing can identify these conditions at the early stages when cure or reversal is most successful. If you wait for obvious signs, it may be too late.

Outstanding care and nutrition has increased the average life span of our pets. It's no longer true that one year is like seven "pet years." In fact, if you think about it, the first year of your kitten's life is more like being fifteen or sixteen. After adolescence, your kitten ages more slowly, more like 4-5 "cat years" per calendar year. At this rate, it's even more important to maintain routine annual exams for your cat.

Feline Companion

Indoor cats have the same basic needs when it comes to healthcare. This plan is designed for cats that are going to be indoor only cats and provides twice yearly examinations and annual immunizations that protect against potentially deadly diseases. It also provides a fecal analysis for intestinal parasites, a urinalysis, along with consultations on nutrition and behavior, along with unlimited office visits during regular business hours.

Feline Explorer

This program is for cats that are going to be outdoors at any time. It is just like our Companion program, with the addition of Feline Leukemia vaccination and Feline AIDS vaccination and two stool sample examinations per year.

Feline Plus

This program is geared for middle aged and older cats or in any cat where there are health concerns. This is the same as our Companion Program with the addition of a CBC and blood tests that ensure internal organs are functioning normally.

Feline Complete

Our most comprehensive plan. This plan is the same as the Plus plan with the addition of a dental prophylaxis cleaning to keep your cat's mouth healthy.
